Cooking Corner

Grandma Jane's Brisket



Ingredients:

First cut brisket (should be triangular shaped)

1 32-40 oz. bottle of ketchup

[2 cups ginger ale (diet or not depending on preference)

2 packets onion soup mix

Steps: Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees Combine soup mix, ketchup and ginger ale Put brisket in deep pan Pour mixture all over <u>and</u> underneath Cover pan tightly with aluminum foil on all sides Cook for 3 hours (don't uncover it) Remove from the oven and unwrap <u>carefully</u> Test for tenderness with a fork When tender enough, remove brisket from pan and place on cutting board Let cool, leaving mixture in pan When brisket is cool enough, cut meet on a diagonal Replace pieces of meat into pan to re-absorb the liquid Enjoy! ~Scott Raynes
